Model of the Future is a fundraising event for Rocky Bay that has been conducted for the past 16 years. Many of our winners have become very successful in their modelling careers both locally and overseas.

AGE GROUPS:

The event is open to young aspiring models (male and female) aged between 5 and 21 years. There are two sections, Junior and Senior.

Junior :

5—7 years

8—10 years

11—12 years

Senior :

13—15 years

16—21 years

HEAT INFORMATION:

There will be eleven heats across the metropolitan area and details of heat locations and times can be downloaded from the Rocky Bay website. Registration will only be at the times stipulated on the web site, no late registrations will be accepted.

Models are required to enter into one heat at a location that suits the individual. Following the heat, models will receive a letter with details of the next step in the competition process.

Each heat will have a registration period, followed by judging. Judges will be looking at the following criteria when judging models:

1. Technique: Modeling - walk, how they hold their head, arms/posture, interaction and rhythm to the music.
2. Coordination: Clothing - does the outfit match, overall appearance, physical co-ordination, fashion sense
3. Potential: Can they go further with their modeling career?

Judges will always look for an “X Factor”

Models should select an outfit for the heats that makes them feel comfortable and showcases them best to the judges, **thongs are not appropriate footwear**. Rocky Bay does not stipulate what models should wear to the heats.
