To ensure you are not subjected to violence, abuse, neglect, discrimination or exploitation whilst in the care of Rocky Bay

Policy

Rocky Bay recognises the right of all people to live free from violence, abuse, exploitation, discrimination and neglect. We make a commitment to:

- Ensure our staff are trained to recognise and act when they see violence, abuse, exploitation or neglect
- Deliver services in places and ways that reduces your risks

In order to deliver our commitment we will ensure:

- All staff have appropriate training and support to reduce your risks
- That training includes how to identify and respond to violence, abuse, neglect and exploitation
- All our staff, volunteers and contractors have been appropriately checked before working at Rocky Bay
- We act quickly on any problems you tell us about or things we see
- We let you know how to report violence, abuse, neglect and exploitation
- We report all matters to appropriate agencies, such as the Police and do so as quickly as possible
- You will be supported during and after any problems you report
- You will be kept well informed throughout any investigations
